The Hoffman Estates Village Board invites you and your guests to a ceremony of remembrance for the victims of the 9/11 terrorist attacks. This special service will be held on Tuesday, Sept. 11, from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Village Hall, 1900 Hassell Road.

John Schneidwind, a resident of Hoffman Estates and a lieutenant with the Schaumburg Fire Department, will be a guest presenter. He assisted in the rescue and recovery efforts at Ground Zero after the attack, and will provide a slideshow depicting the devastation as well as the courage, strength and determination of the rescuers, volunteers and survivors.

Mayor Bill McLeod will serve as master of ceremonies, followed by inspirational messages from the religious community. The ceremony will also feature a color guard composed of members of the Hoffman Estates Police and Fire Departments.

The Village’s Patriot Day remembrance service has always been a well-attended event, and people of varied ethnic backgrounds come together to express their mutual grief over what took place on Sept. 11, 2001.
