Assessing damage to your property in Hoffman Estates

Governor Blagojevich declared several northern Illinois counties, including Cook County, disaster areas due to the storms of Aug. 23, 2007. In an attempt to have Cook County declared a federal disaster area, Cook County Emergency Management Agency has requested individual municipalities in Cook County to assess the amount of uninsured damage in their respective villages, towns and cities.

The Village of Hoffman Estates is therefore asking residents who sustained storm damage to respond to the Village by supplying the cost estimate of damage.

All residents will be receiving a letter from the Village of Hoffman Estates requesting this basic damage information that will be used by the county and state to assist in qualifying for federal relief funds.
