OVERVIEW OF THE HOFFMAN ESTATES FIRE DEPARTMENT CITIZEN FIRE ACADEMY

INTRODUCTION

The Hoffman Estates Fire Department Citizen Fire Academy includes approximately 33 hours of instruction. Class sessions are approximately 3 hours in length and are held at Fire Station 24, 5775 Beacon Pointe. Some classes are held in other locations based on the specific topic.

The Academy will conclude with a graduation ceremony at the Village Hall before the Mayor and Trustees. Graduating students will receive a certificate of completion from the Hoffman Estates Fire Department and the Village of Hoffman Estates.

OBJECTIVES

To better inform the residents of Hoffman Estates as to the purpose and inner workings of the Hoffman Estates Fire Department. To discover what diverse services the Fire Department offers our community.

To encourage citizens to return to their neighborhoods and relay to their friends the proper procedures to use to become more safety-conscious citizens.

To provide an interactive forum for both the Fire Department and the citizens of the academy.

ANTICIPATED BENEFITS

The opportunity to receive basic CPR instruction and fundamental knowledge in first aid procedures.

The opportunity to be able to react in a positive manner should some type of fire or medical emergency arise.

An increased awareness and knowledge to keep your home and workplace accident free.

A better understanding of why and how the Fire Department operates in an emergency.

The opportunity to interact and address community concerns relative to the Fire Department.

INSTRUCTORS

All class instructors are members of the Hoffman Estates Fire Department and are committed to providing appropriate information to all participants in the Fire Academy. All instructors are a minimum State of Illinois Certified Firefighter II. Members of the department will be available to class participants during the Academy to answer questions or demonstrate various techniques.

CLASS SIZE/SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

Each session will average 15 participants. A larger group inhibits frequent interaction between participants and instructors. **SAFETY** is of the utmost concern, and limiting participants allows for a safer learning environment.

Citizens are selected based on demographics and the citizen's ability to reach other members in their community. In preparing for each academy, efforts will be made to include members of the educational, religious, business and ethnic communities, as well as media representatives. Final selection of participants rests with Fire Department Administration. Participants will be contacted to ensure they are familiar with the program and the time commitment involved.

MEASURING THE ACADEMY'S SUCCESS

In order to keep the program informative and interesting, participants are encouraged to critique the program throughout its entirety. Enhancements to the program will be implemented as a result of the feedback received from the participants.

Students are encouraged to participate in all practical demonstrations and to interact with the instructors and one another.

IT IS IMPERATIVE FOR THE PARTICIPANTS TO REALIZE THAT THE CITIZEN FIRE ACADEMY IS A LEARNING EXPERIENCE TO HELP THEM BETTER HANDLE THEMSELVES IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS. IT IS NOT INTENDED TO TRAIN THEM AS FIREFIGHTERS OR ASSISTANTS AT A FIRE.

RELEASE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE

In exchange for the opportunity to observe and participate in the authorized operations of the Village of Hoffman Estates Fire Department, which activity may place me in a position of danger, the undersigned agrees to:

1. Release and waive any and all claims, causes of action, or other means of legal recourse that the undersigned may have against the Village of Hoffman Estates agents, and employees that may arise from or be caused by my participation in the authorized operations of either department;
2. Indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the Village of Hoffman Estates and its officials, agents, and employees for any and all claims, causes of action, or other means of legal recourse that may arise from or be caused by my participation in the authorized operations;
3. Covenant not to sue the Village of Hoffman Estates and its officials, agents, and employees for damages that may arise from or be caused by my participation in the authorized operations.

By signing this document, the undersigned acknowledges that he or she is not and will not be acting as an employee or agent of the Village of Hoffman Estates and is specifically waiving, in addition to the waiver set forth above, any right to Workers' Compensation benefits. The undersigned further acknowledges that the release, waiver, hold harmless, and covenant not to sue shall be binding on the undersigned's heirs and personal representative. The undersigned further acknowledges that permission to observe and participate in authorized operations is terminable at the will of any Village official, agent, or employee without notice or formal process and that this release and hold harmless shall be applicable whenever the undersigned is observing or participating in authorized operations.

The undersigned acknowledges that the execution of this release is done as a free and voluntary act.
