Winter Energy Tips

There are a few simple ways for you to make sure your home is efficiently keeping the warm air in and the cold air out.

- Change your furnace filter monthly.
- If needed, have your heating system tuned-up by a professional (keep all heat registers and air ducts clear of obstructions).
- If buying a new furnace look for one that is Energy Star approved for energy efficiency.
- Remove window air conditioning unit from your windows during the winter months, or fill the cracks with weather stripping. Seal drafty windows with plastic.
- Replace any weather-stripping or caulking that may be damaged.
